

State Administrative Committee Elections

Election for 2005-2007

Please fill out the nomination form below and return no later than March 18th. Elections will be conducted in April. If there are no run-offs, results will be announced in May. The new committee will be filled and take office June 1, 2005.

According to the USAG Operating Code:

State Administrative Committee Members (SACM) must be:

- 1. Women's Program Professional Members in good standing.**
- 2. A minimum of 21 years of age**
- 3. Active in that States Program**

According to page 10 of the USAG Operating Code:

- 1. Resumes will be gathered from nominees.**
- 2. An election commission shall be established in the state to tabulate the votes and verify results. Elections results should be verified in writing by the election commission.**
 - a. The election commission shall consist of no less than three persons. The chairman of this committee shall be a non- member of USA Gymnastics.**
 - b. The names of the election commission will be published with the request for nominations.**
- 3. Nominees agree to**
 - a. Represent their area and/or level**
 - b. Support and consider the entire state program**
 - c. Carry out the specific duties of their positions**
 - d. Attend all committee and general membership meetings**
- 4. No signature will be required on ballots. Ballots will be made verifiable by pro numbers.**
- 5. Only official (valid) ballots will be counted (no copies or faxes).**
- 6. Ballots will be sent to the Chairman of the election commission.**
- 7. Write in votes will not be allowed**
- 8. The winner of the election will be the candidate who receives the most votes. If there is a tie, the State Administrative Committee Chairman will vote to break the tie. In only one nomination for a position is received, the SASCC will cast one vote and the nominee will win by acclamation.**
- 9. The State Administrative Committee Chairman will send a copy of the verified vote count to candidates in each respective election, upon request on the candidate. A copy of this information shall also be sent to the Regional Administrative Committee Chairman.**

The Alabama State Administrative Committee is composed of eight positions (the chairman only votes in case of a tie). Appointed State Administrative Committee Members shall serve a one year term, which may be renewed at the discretion of the SACC, SAC, or both.
